

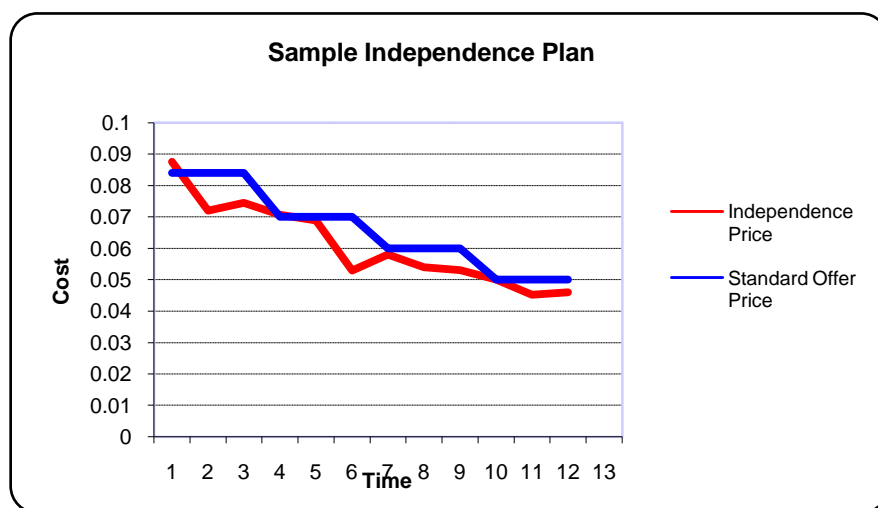


Independence Plan "Light"

Product Summary

In instances where electricity prices are declining, or if there is substantial "off peak" usage, the Patriot Energy Independence Plan is a great option. The Independence Plan allows customers to purchase their electricity directly from the Power Pool similar to the way wholesale suppliers do. Electricity is priced hourly throughout the day. The price is largely dependant upon demand. Since most business demand electricity from the grid during "peak" times, power is typically more expensive during those hours. During "off peak" hours, the price is typically lower. As a result, businesses using "off peak" power more often than the average user should benefit from these lower prices, as the utility offers only one price for a 24 hour day based on their entire customer profile.

In addition, Standard Offer Service in Maine is determined by short term fixed positions set at particular times during the year (quarterly or bi-annually depending on class of service). In a declining market, a fixed price can lead to a higher overall cost than a floating price as the price is fixed & held for a period of time while the floating price continues to fall. For that reason, the Independence Plan is ideal for the falling electricity market environment.

Independence Price Calculation

NE-ISO Index + Retail Adder = Independence Price
 ex: 7.9 cents + 1.6 cents = 9.5 cents

Retail Adder includes the variable components of capacity, renewable energy, ancillary services & losses along with fixed administration costs.

The term "NE-ISO" represents the hourly and/or day ahead clearing price as posted by the NE-ISO.
